Patricia Weinert is working as EU and global affairs senior project coordinator at the Institute for interdisciplinary dermatological Prevention and Rehabilitation at the University of Osnabrück (iDerm). She coordinates the European and international projects of the Institute and develops strategic partnerships with regional and international institutions to enhance international exchange on prevention strategies for occupational skin diseases (OSD). She led a 3-year research project on 'health at work' within the EU-funded Innovation Incubator at the Leuphana University Lüneburg, which looked into improving healthy workplaces in small- and medium- sized enterprises particularly confronted with high incidences of OSD.

Prior to her current job, she has been working for almost 25 years within the UN system, first in the area of International Migration for the International Labour Organization (ILO) and then as senior project manager for the International Social Security Association (ISSA) in Geneva. She was responsible for the Association's worldwide prevention programme and acted as ISSA's coordinator of the World Congress on Safety and Health at Work, organized every three years together with the International Labour Organization (ILO).
